Amendment to H.R. 1890 Offered by Mr. Doggett of Texas

Page 51, add the following after line 25:

1 (D) ACCESS TO INFORMATION BY CON-2 GRESSIONAL STAFF.—In no case shall access to 3 information under subparagraph (B)(ii) by 4 Members' staff or committee staff require a se-5 curity clearance above the level under which the 6 information is classified.

7 (E) TIMING OF ACCESS TO INFORMA8 TION.—Information shall be made available
9 under subparagraph (B)(ii) to Members of Con10 gress, their staff, and committee staff no later
11 than the date on which such information is
12 made available to the government of a foreign
13 country that is a party to the negotiations.

Page 58, insert the following after line 22:

(D) TIMING OF ACCESS TO INFORMA-TION.—Information shall be made available under subparagraph (B)(ii) to members of the congressional advisory groups and staff no later than the date on which such information is made available to the government of a foreign country that is a party to the negotiations.

Page 62, line 4, Strike "ESTABLISHMENT" and insert "Commitment to Greater Transparency and ESTABLISHMENT".

Page 62, line 9, strike "(4)" and insert "(5)"

Page 62, line 17, strike the quotation marks and end period.

Page 62, insert the following after line 17:

10 "(4) Consistent with effective negotiations, the 11 United States Trade Representative shall encourage max-12 imum accessibility to trade texts, the proposals made by 13 the United States and other trading partners. The policy 14 is to make negotiations as open as possible and to identify 15 major issues that are the subject of negotiations.".
