AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1890 OFFERED BY REP. PASCRELL

This amendment would prohibit trade agreements that permit the import of food, feed, or food ingredients or products that do not meet or exceed U.S. standards with respect to food safety, pesticides, inspections, packaging, and labeling into the United States from a country that is a party to the trade agreement.

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1890 OFFERED BY MR. PASCRELL OF NEW JERSEY

Page 97, after line 7, insert the following:

1 (6) FOR FAILURE TO MEET FOOD SAFETY AND OTHER STANDARDS.—The trade authorities procedures shall not apply to any implementing bill submitted with respect to a trade agreement or trade agreements that permits the importation of food, feed, food ingredients, and other related food products that do not meet or exceed United States standards with respect to food safety, pesticides, inspections, packaging, and labeling into the United States from a country that is a party to the trade agreement.
