AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1890 OFFERED BY REP. PASCRELL

This amendment would prohibit trade agreements that do not include rules of origin to ensure that the benefits of the trade agreement accrue to the parties of the trade agreement, particularly with respect to goods produced in the U.S. and goods that incorporate materials produced in the U.S.

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1890 OFFERED BY MR. PASCRELL OF NEW JERSEY

Page 97, after line 7, insert the following:

(6) For Failure to Include Strong Rules of Origin.—The trade authorities procedures shall not apply to any implementing bill submitted with respect to a trade agreement bill submitted with respect to a trade agreement or trade agreements that does not include rules of origin that ensure, to the maximum extent feasible, that the benefits of the trade agreement agreement accrue to the parties of the trade agreement, particularly with respect to goods produced in the United States and goods that incorporate materials produced in the United States.

(7) For Failure to Include Strong Rules of Origin for Automotive Products.—The trade authorities procedures shall not apply to any implementing bill submitted with respect to a trade agreement bill submitted with respect to a trade agreement or trade agreements that does not include rules of origin at least as stringent as the rule in the North American Free Trade Agreement.
