Re: House Rule XI Request for a Special Meeting

Dear Chairman Smith,

We write to request that you immediately call a special meeting of the Committee on Ways and Means and invite Acting Commissioner Scott Bessent of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to discuss agency operations amid alarming reports regarding employee furloughs and the Administration's reported plans to target taxpayers based on political beliefs.

Americans all across this country are experiencing the hardship and growing chaos created by an out-of-control President with an out-of-touch agenda under one-party Republican rule in Washington. This extends to the dismantling of key government agencies providing essential services to Americans. As you know, the IRS furloughed nearly one-half of its employees (over 34,000 federal workers) and sent reduction-in-force (RIF) notices. Despite requests, the IRS has refused to provide any information on the specifics (numerical breakdown by state, campus location, etc.) of these actions. Without this information, the Committee does not know how the furloughs and RIF notices are affecting refund delays, processing backlogs, and taxpayer services around the country.

Further, there are media reports that the Administration is preparing sweeping changes at the IRS criminal-investigative division that would allow the agency to pursue inquiries of Democratic donors and groups, including a list of potential targets. As you know, Section 7217 of the Internal Revenue Code prohibits the President and members of his executive office from requesting or directing the IRS to target any particular taxpayer, whether an individual or an organization. The Committee, as a whole, has made clear in the past that taxpayers should not be targeted based on political beliefs.
