A BILL

- To amend part D of title XVIII of the Social Security Act to require the Secretary of Health and Human Services to negotiate lower covered part D drug prices on behalf of Medicare beneficiaries.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Prescription
 - 5 Drug Price Negotiation Act of 2007".

1	SEC. 2. NEGOTIATION OF LOWER COVERED PART D DRUG
2	PRICES ON BEHALF OF MEDICARE BENE-
3	FICIARIES.
4	(a) Negotiation by HHS.—Section 1860D-11 of
5	the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w-111) is amend-
6	ed by striking subsection (i) (relating to noninterference)
7	and inserting the following:
8	"(i) Negotiation of Lower Drug Prices.—
9	"(1) In General.—Notwithstanding any other
10	provision of law, the Secretary shall negotiate with
11	pharmaceutical manufacturers the prices that may
12	be charged for covered part D drugs for part D eli-
13	gible individuals who are enrolled under a prescrip-
14	tion drug plan or under an MA-PD plan.
15	"(2) No change in rules for
16	FORMULARIES.—
17	"(A) In general.—Nothing in paragraph
18	(1) shall be construed to authorize the Sec-
19	retary to establish or require a particular for-
20	mulary.
21	"(B) Construction.—Subparagraph (A)
22	shall not be construed as affecting the Sec-
23	retary's authority to ensure appropriate and
24	adequate access to covered part D drugs under
25	prescription drug plans and under MA-PD

3	"(3) Construction.—Nothing in this sub-
4	section shall be construed as preventing the sponsor
5	of a prescription drug plan, or an organization offer-
6	ing an MA-PD plan, from obtaining a discount or
7	reduction of the price for a covered part D drug
8	below the price negotiated under paragraph (1).
9	"(4) Semi-annual reports to congress.—
10	Not later than June 1, 2007, and every six months
11	thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to the Com-
12	mittees on Ways and Means, Energy and Commerce,
13	and Government Reform of the House of Represent-
14	atives and the Committee on Finance of the Senate
15	a report on negotiations conducted by the Secretary
16	to achieve lower prices for Medicare beneficiaries,
17	and the prices and price discounts achieved by the
18	Secretary as a result of such negotiations.".
19	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
20	subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
21	ment of this Act and shall first apply to negotiations and
22	prices for plan years beginning on January 1, 2008.
